VIRTUAL COMMUNITY FORUM: CRITICAL INFRASTRUCTURE PROGRAM

**May 14, 2020
6:30 PM - 8:30 PM**

The public is invited and encouraged to participate in a virtual community forum being hosted by the San Mateo County Harbor District to discuss and provide input on the prioritization of the District’s current Capital Improvement Program. The input provided in the forum will be summarized and submitted to the Board of Harbor Commissioners for their use and consideration in developing the Operational/Capital Improvement Program Budget for Fiscal Year 2020/2021.

The forum will include a presentation with an introduction to the District, a quick photo tour of the Harbor and Marina, and a summary of all the potential upgrades, replacements, and new Facilities. There will be time for public input and a summary of next steps in the budget process.

Pursuant to the Shelter-in-Place Order issued by the San Mateo County Health Officer on March 16, 2020, as revised on March 31, 2020, the statewide Shelter-in-Place Order issued by the Governor in Executive Order N-33-20 on March 19, 2020, and the CDC’s social distancing guidelines which discourage large public gatherings, the Boardroom will not be open for the May 14, 2020 Community Forum. The forum will be conducted remotely via video/teleconference.
