Video links in the email below clearly demonstrate numerous access problems at Johnson Pier.

Wherever a hoist is located on Johnson Pier there is also a squid off-loading operation. Squid off-loading equipment, operations, and crew require adequate space. Locating a hoist and squid off-loading next to the eighteen-wheeler semi-trailer truck loading area is extremely dangerous. Please watch the video "Squid Madness" (<http://bit.ly/2GAQtdn>) to better understand the volume of forklift and semi-trailer truck traffic at Pillar Point Harbor during squid season.

On Johnson Pier three businesses compete to load bins brimming with squid into semi-trailers as fast as possible. Based on the way Johnson Pier is currently configured it is unwise to locate a hoist near the semi-trailer truck loading zone used by three fish buying businesses. Doing so would block access to a majority (2 out of 3) of the fish buying businesses and create havoc on a pier used by the public as well as the commercial fishing industry.

I strongly support the concerns raised by the Half Moon Bay Seafood Marketing Association.

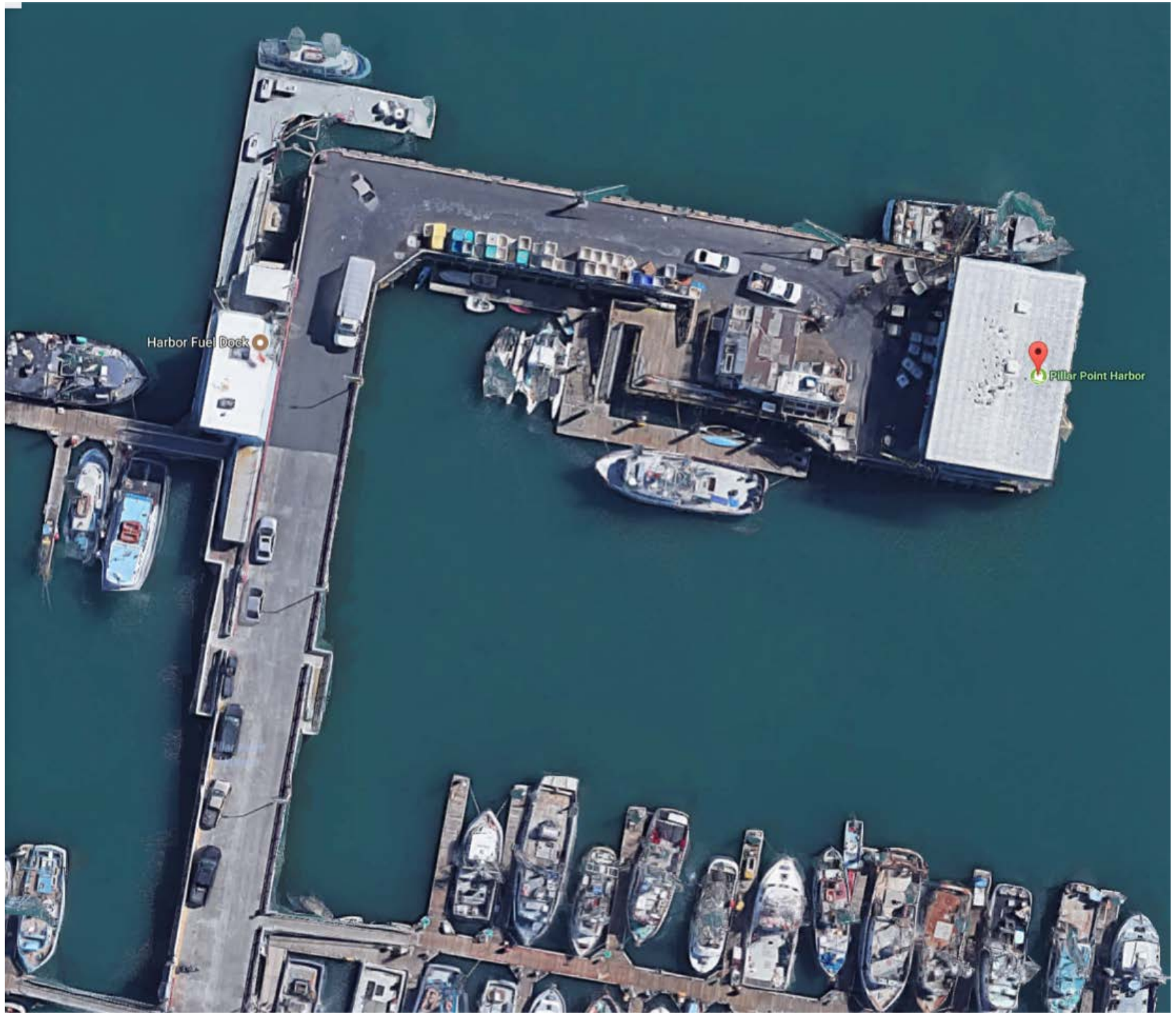
