### Tenant Long Term Parking Request Authorization

San Mateo County Harbor District Ordinance Code Section 3.7.2.3: Permission must be obtained from the Harbormaster prior to parking any vehicle, trailer or boat in the parking area at, in or within the District facilities for a period exceeding seventy-two (72) consecutive hours. If permission is not requested or granted, the vehicle, trailer or boat will be removed and stored at the owner's expense. Prior to release of said vehicle, all fees for towing and storage shall be paid.

Harbormaster Terms: Harbormaster and facility staff assume no responsibility for the safety or security of vehicles, trailers, or boats parking for extended periods in the parking areas of Oyster Point Marina Park. It shall be understood by all parties that the parking areas are considered South San Francisco City Streets and the Police Department has ultimate authority over all parking enforcement. Though facility staff does everything in their power to ensure the security of the facility and the users of this facility they cannot prevent nor should be considered able to prevent any lawful acts. Harbormaster will only consider granting permission for the long-term parking of vehicles, trailers, and or boats up to twenty-one (21) days.
